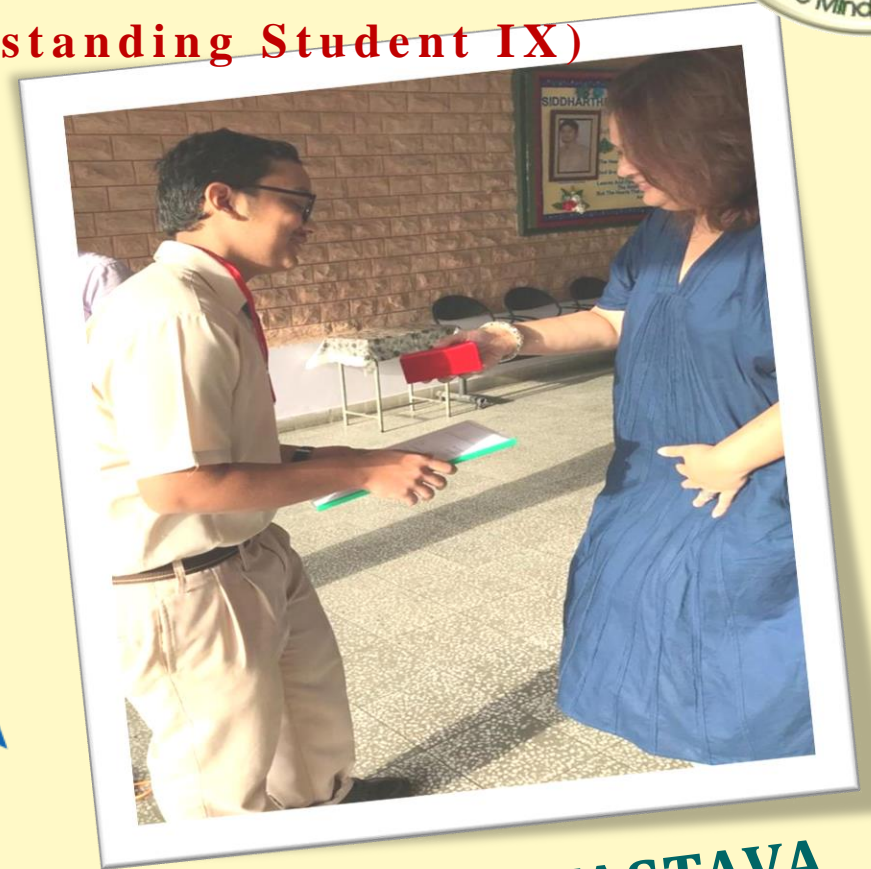

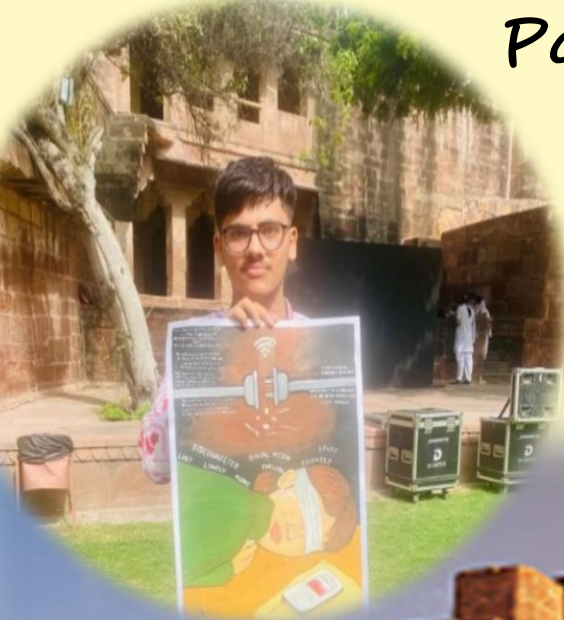

CAREER GUIDANCE & COUNSELLING SESSION

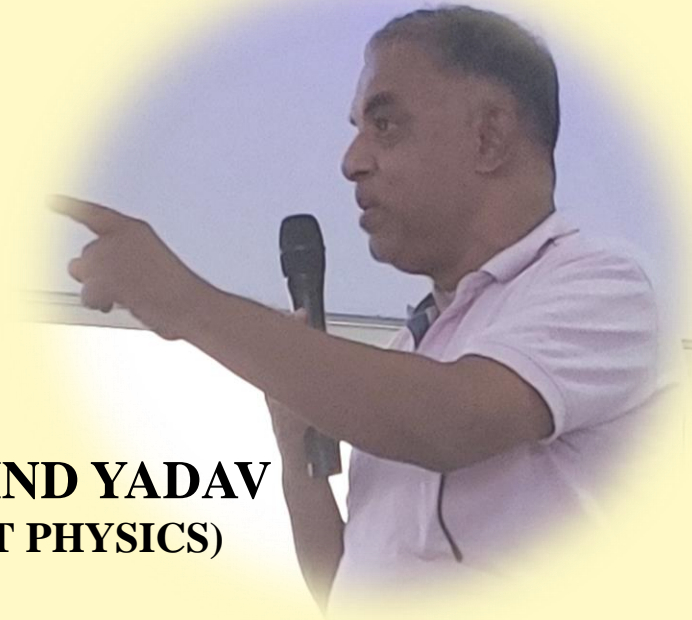
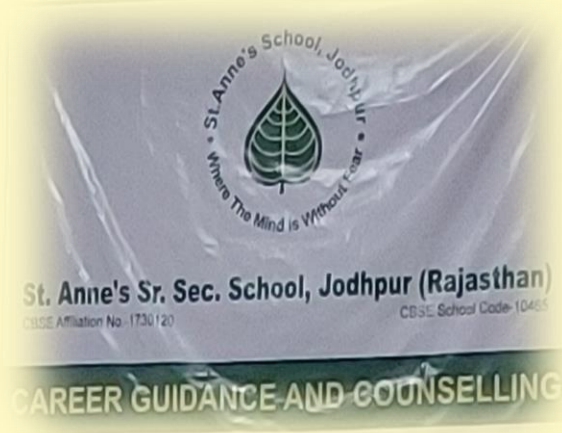

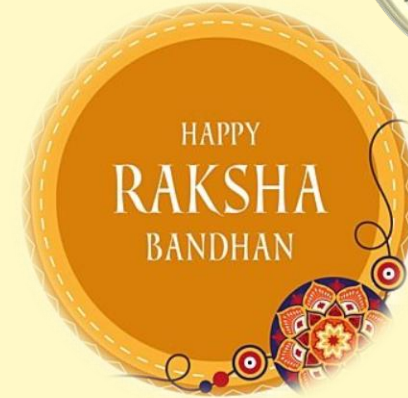
